The Marine Management Organisation (MMO) received the "Rule 8" letter in relation to the application by Eggborough Power Limited ("the Applicant") for an order Granting Development Consent for the Eggborough CCGT Project on 4 October 2017.

In accordance with the Rule 8 letter the MMO wishes to be considered as an Interested Party and requests the opportunity to make oral representations at the Issue Specific Hearing(s) if, at that stage, there are matters still outstanding between us and the Applicant.

The MMO notes that Deadline 1 is the deadline for receipt of the Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) between ourselves and the Applicant. The MMO received a draft SoCG from Dalton Warner Davies, on behalf of the Applicant, at 16:00 on 10 October 2017.

At this stage we are unable to agree with the SoCG as drafted due to the limited time for review and consideration. The MMO has requested a draft SoCG a number of times from the Applicant, indeed as early as 22 March 2017, however we will continue to work with the Applicant and seek to agree matters, where appropriate, as early as possible in the Examination process.
